## **PRO-LIFE UPDATE, AUGUST 2023**

Once again there was a mixture of good and bad news on the Pro-Life front this past month. First the good news. Illinois Governor Pritzker signed a new law (SB 1909) directed against Pro-Life crisis pregnancy centers which provide pregnancy testing, information regarding childbirth and parenting, car seats, baby food, etc. but, of course offer no information or resources on abortion. The pregnancy centers make no charges for their services. Most of their staffs are volunteers. The law provides for possible penalties of up to \$50,000 for any pregnancy center which engages in "any deception, fraud, false pretense, false promise or misrepresentation" including omitting "any material fact, with the intent that others rely on ... the omission of such material fact." Lawyers with the Thomas More Society within hours of the enactment of SB 1909 filed suit, on First Amendment grounds, seeking an injunction stopping enforcement of the law on behalf of the National Institute of Family and Life Advocates and other Pro-Life entities. One of the Plaintiffs, Rockford Family Initiative, holds prayer vigils and performs "sidewalk counseling" near abortion clinics. They were concerned, for example, that SB 1909 would be enforced against them if they stated that "a fetus is a human" or that "life begins at conception." On August 4, 2023 the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Illinois granted the motion for a preliminary injunction against the law and issued a very strong 14 page order finding that the law would violate the First Amendment, free speech rights of the Plaintiffs. The injunction is preliminary only. The suit will continue and the injunction may be vacated or otherwise changed. If the Court's ruling becomes final, it will very likely be appealed but for now Illinois crisis pregnancy centers are safe from enforcement of this law which very likely was intended to stop their Pro-Life efforts and put them out of business.

In our March, April, and May issues of the Pro-Life Update, we discussed the important questions arising from abortions caused by administration of drugs, in particular the pill Mifepristone. Presently, the majority of abortions in our country are performed in that way rather than by surgery. In April the United States Appellate Court for the Fifth Circuit issued a preliminary order allowing this drug to remain on the market but restricting how it is dispensed and prescribed the issued according to rules promulgated by the Federal Food and Drug Administration (FDA). In a 96 page ruling issued on August 16, 2023, that Court ruled that the FDA was wrong when it allowed: (1) use of the drug anytime up to 10 weeks of gestation rather than the previous restriction of no later than 7 weeks; (2) prescription of mifepristone by medical professionals other than physicians; and (3) delivery to pregnant women by mail. However the Fifth Circuit ruling is subject to a previously issued U.S. Supreme Court order placing all such changes on hold pending further litigation. It is likely that the Supreme Court will have the final say on this issue sometime next year.

In our July Pro-Life Update, we reported on abortion news from the State of Ohio regarding two ballot propositions scheduled to be voted upon in August and November 2023. On November 7, 2023, Ohioans will vote on a proposed amendment to the state constitution which, if passed, would allow abortion any time up to viability (generally thought to be at about 24 weeks) and would also legalize abortion after viability if "in the professional judgment of the pregnant patient's treating physician [abortion] is necessary to protect the pregnant patient's life or health." In effect this would likely make abortion legal even after viability because the term regarding the "health" of a pregnant woman will be construed, according to the amendment itself, quite broadly. This definition is like the one spelled out in the Illinois Reproductive Health Act to include "all factors that are relevant to the patient's health and well-being including but not limited to, physical, emotional, psychological, and familial health and age." On August 8, 2023, Ohio voters rejected a proposed law which would have required a vote of 60% + 1 rather than a simple majority to amend the state constitution. Therefore, if there is a majority vote in favor of the proposed amendment on November 7, 2023, Ohio will have a radical pro-abortion law similar to the one we have in Illinois. Please re-double your prayer efforts to save the lives of Ohio babies.

### August 27, 2023 - 21<sup>st</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

Isn't it a bit weird that Catholics call the Pope "papa," father? This Sunday provides us with essential Scriptural background on the papacy, the petrine office. Jesus gives Peter the "keys to the kingdom of heaven," after witnessing to the special grace Peter has to know Jesus' true identity. Many have pointed out that the "keys" refer back to the figure of Eliakim, King David's prime minister. True enough. But notice this is not mere authority or power. It's a family relationship. The Lord says to Eliakim, "He shall be a father to the inhabitants of Jerusalem" (Isaiah 22:21). David's prime minister was a spiritual *father* to the family of Israel. Peter, and his successors, will be spiritual fathers in the family of the Church.

This means we have a serious obligation to not only recognize the Pope's authority, but also to love him with the affection of children for their papa. We should never speak about him with disrespect or rancor. We should listen to him with trusting hearts, and ignore the slander thrown at him in various media. When we show the world we are loving and obedient to our Holy Papa, perhaps they'll see more clearly that the Church is indeed God's beloved family.




