## Introduction to the Liturgy of the Day

Over the last two thousand years Jesus has been given many titles, from Bread of Life to Our Savior. One of his first titles, going back to when he first stood and proclaimed God's word in the synagogue, is Rabbi, or Teacher. How appropriate to focus on that title on this first Sunday of September, a time of year when millions of young people are returning to school. Today we hear Jesus teach the crowds what it means to be a disciple. May he teach us as well as we gather together in his name.

# God is with Us!

## Pastor's Column

*Discipleship requires full surrender to God's way.*

Great crowds were traveling with Jesus, and he turned and addressed them, “If anyone comes to me without hating his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple. Whoever does not carry his own cross and comes after me cannot be my disciple. Jesus’ words to the crowds are difficult to hear. The demands he makes of his disciples are too much. Hate your family? Carry your own cross? Renouncing all your possessions? They range from unreasonable to unthinkable. Can he possibly mean to be so harsh? First, the use of the word hate can be interpreted and translated from one language to another in different ways. In this context, I would say for our culture “reject,” or renounce not “hate,” could be more appropriate. As humans, our main weakness is making our children, spouses, parents or members of our family more important to us than God. We make them gods and serve them with the best of ourselves. If you do it Jesus’ way, then it will look like you “hate” them. It is exactly this, that Jesus is asking of us as his disciples.

Secondly, possessions can also be gods. It is a second great human weakness after family, to love possessions and money. Renouncing all possessions doesn’t necessarily mean leaving oneself destitute, but no longer regarding what you have as your own property. To follow Jesus means to choose Jesus, who gives us everything we need, even the promise of eternal life, over those things most dear to us: our families, our homes, our wealth, and all our “stuff.” Let us look to his first disciples: the twelve apostles. They left their families, their homes, and their possessions, choosing to live a difficult lifestyle instead. Every day they calculated the cost of discipleship and concluded that following Jesus was worth everything they gave up.

Saint Paul asks his convert Philemon to do something radical and selfless: to welcome back Onesimus, who ran away and found Christ, and accept him not as a slave but as a brother. Onesimus, whom Paul trusted to return to Philemon and deliver this letter, could have kept running rather than take the chance that Philemon would ignore the letter and re-enslave him. The fact that this letter not only survived but became part of the Bible implies that Philemon kept it and agreed to Paul’s appeal.

Discipleship demands we make radical and selfless choices. It requires us to make a commitment to walk the walk or just stay as we are. Jesus’ way contradicts cultural beliefs and ways of doing things. It contradicts our own way of thinking and doing things. It requires a full submission to Jesus’ way. I am human and he is God. He is the way, the truth and life. I surrender and give up everything to follow him. It is a daily commitment.

# **¡Dios está con nosotros!**

## **Columna del Pastor**

*El discipulado requiere una entrega total al camino de Dios.*

En aquel tiempo, caminaba con Jesús una gran muchedumbre y él, volviéndose a sus discípulos, les dijo: "Si alguno quiere seguirme y no me prefiere a su padre y a su madre, a su esposa y a sus hijos, a sus hermanos y a sus hermanas, más aún, a sí mismo, no puede ser mi discípulo. Y el que no carga su cruz y me sigue, no puede ser mi discípulo. Las palabras de Jesús a la multitud son difíciles de escuchar Lo que le exige a sus discípulos es demasiado. ¿Preferirlo a él más que a la propia familia? ¿Cargar tu propia cruz? ¿Renunciar a los propios bienes? Estas cosas pasan de irrazonables a impensables. ¿Es posible que Jesús quiera ser tan severo? En primer lugar, como seres humanos, nuestra principal debilidad es dar a nuestros hijos, cónyuges, padres o familiares más importancia que a Dios. Los convertimos en dioses y les servimos con lo mejor de nosotros mismos. Si lo haces a la manera de Jesús, parecerá que los odias. Es precisamente eso lo que Jesús nos pide como discípulos.

En segundo lugar, las posesiones también pueden ser dioses. Es una segunda gran debilidad humana, después de la familia, amar las posesiones y el dinero. Renunciar a todas las posesiones no significa necesariamente quedarse en la indigencia, sino dejar de considerar lo que se tiene como propio. Seguir a Jesús significa elegir a Jesús, quien nos da todo lo que necesitamos, incluso la promesa de la vida eterna, por encima de aquello que más apreciamos: nuestras familias, nuestros hogares, nuestras riquezas y todas nuestras pertenencias. Observemos a sus primeros discípulos: los doce apóstoles. Dejaron sus familias, sus hogares y sus posesiones, optando por un estilo de vida difícil. Cada día calculaban el coste del discipulado y concluían que seguir a Jesús valía todo lo que renunciaban.

San Pablo le pide a su converso Filemón que haga algo radical y desinteresado: acoger de nuevo a Onésimo, quien huyó y encontró a Cristo, y aceptarlo no como esclavo, sino como hermano. Onésimo, en quien Pablo confiaba para que regresara a Filemón y le entregara esta carta, podría haber seguido huyendo en lugar de correr el riesgo de que Filemón ignorara la carta y lo volviera a esclavizar. El hecho de que esta carta no solo sobreviviera, sino que se convirtiera en parte de la Biblia, implica que Filemón la conservó y accedió a la súplica de Pablo.

El discipulado exige que tomemos decisiones radicales y desinteresadas. Requiere que nos comprometamos a vivir como lo hacemos o simplemente a quedarnos como estamos. El camino de Jesús contradice las creencias culturales y la forma de hacer las cosas. Contradice nuestra propia manera de pensar y hacer las cosas. Requiere una sumisión total al camino de Jesús. Soy humano y él es Dios. Él es el camino, la verdad y la vida. Me entrego y lo dejo todo para seguirlo. Es un compromiso diario.





### Memorial Service for Aborted Children at St. Mary Cemetery in Evergreen Park on Saturday, September 13<sup>th</sup>

On Saturday, September 13th, pro-life Americans throughout the country will gather at the gravesites of aborted babies and other memorial sites dedicated in their honor for the 13<sup>th</sup> annual National Day of Remembrance for Aborted Children. Solemn vigils will be held at these sites to commemorate the more than 65 million children who have lost their lives to legal abortion since 1973, and to remind our society of the humanity of the unborn child. The memorial service at St. Mary Cemetery takes place at the gravesite of 500 babies who were discovered and retrieved from the garbage dumpsters of several downtown Chicago abortion facilities in early 1987. It is one of the earliest of the gravesites across the United States. Please join us for the memorial service in our community:
