The Solemnity of All Saints Day is observed on November 1. The Church celebrates holy men and women throughout the year on various saint days, but the Solemnity of All Saints is when the Church honors every saint, known and unknown. While we have information about many saints, and we honor them on specific days, there are many unknown or unsung saints, who may have been forgotten, or never been honored specifically. On All Saints Day, we celebrate these holy individuals, and ask for their prayers and intercessions. *All Saints Day is Wednesday, November 1. It is a Holyday of Obligation. There are two bilingual Masses: 8:30 am and 7 pm.*

FR. ISMAEL'S THOUGHTS

When I preside at baptismal celebrations, I tell parents and godparents that the commitment they are making by baptizing their child is to teach the child to love God and neighbor: teaching the love of God by prayer and celebration of the sacraments, especially the Eucharist, and the love of neighbor by being kind, generous, and compassionate with all. This is the core teaching of our Catholic faith.

When Jesus is asked by the Pharisees about the greatest commandment, He does not hesitate in answering *you shall love the Lord, your God... and your neighbor as yourself. The whole law and the prophets depend on these two commandments.* And we know that since we were children, in what concrete ways do we express these two commandments? When people look at the way we live, the way we conduct our lives every single day, could they say that we really love God and our neighbor?

As some of you probably do, every night we should make an examination of conscience to evaluate how we act as followers of Jesus, especially in the way we treat our neighbors. The corporal works of mercy are a great way to show the compassion Jesus is asking us: feed the hungry, give drink to the thirsty, clothe the naked, visit the imprisoned, shelter the homeless, visit the sick, bury the dead. May we really show our love for God in the way we love and care for our neighbors.

CHURCH BOILER

Cuando la gente ve la manera que vivimos, como llevamos nuestra vida cada día, ¿podría decir que realmente amamos a Dios y a nuestro prójimo?

Como probablemente hacen algunos de ustedes, todas las noches deberíamos de hacer un examen de conciencia para evaluar cómo hemos actuado como seguidores de Jesús, especialmente en la forma en que tratamos a nuestro prójimo. Las obras corporales de misericordia son una muy buena manera de mostrar la compasión que Jesús nos pide: alimentar al hambriento, dar de beber al sediento, vestir al desnudo, hospedar al extranjero, visitar al enfermo y al encarcelado y enterrar al difunto. Que realmente podamos mostrar nuestro amor a Dios en la manera que amamos y cuidamos de nuestros prójimos.





PRO-LIFE UPDATE, OCTOBER 2023

October is the month of the Holy Rosary and has been set aside by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) as Respect Life Month. At Blessed Sacrament Parish we started it with our monthly Mass and Pro-life Rosary on the first Saturday of October. Bishop Michael F. Burbridge, Chairman of the USCCB Committee on Pro-Life Activities, issued a statement inviting all Catholics to “think about building a culture of life in terms of radical solidarity. . . Our prayers, witness, sacrifices, advocacy and good works are needed now more than ever . . . For more information on how to celebrate Respect Life Month and stand in radical solidarity with moms in need please visit respectlife.org/celebrate.”

Two months ago, in our August Pro-Life Update, we reported on an upcoming election in the State of Ohio. On November 7, 2023, Ohioans will vote on a proposed amendment to the state constitution known as Issue 1 which would make abortion a fundamental right in Ohio. It would allow abortion any time up to viability -- about 24 weeks gestation. A pregnancy is generally considered about 39 – 40 months. Issue 1 would also legalize abortion after the unborn baby is viable (capable of living outside the womb) if “in the professional judgment of the pregnant patient’s treating physician [abortion] is necessary to protect the pregnant patient’s life or health.” The “treating physician” could even be the abortionist. Ohio has been a pro-life state but that may be about to change in a very negative direction. The law in Illinois has already reached this unfortunate position due to the statutes passed within the past few years. See our previous Pro-Life Updates explaining the current Illinois statutes. The voters in Ohio still have a chance to prevent this situation there. To oppose Issue 1 a number of Ohio religious and secular pro-life organization have combined their efforts into Protect Women Ohio. See <https://protectwomenohio.com/about>. A one-hour debate between proponents and opponents of the Ohio amendment was held on October 11, 2023. It can be viewed on YouTube <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=cED1PFn1FgI>. Between now and November 7 we should all pray for the defeat of the Ohio amendment which, if adopted, would result in the death of many innocent babies in the womb.

The New York Times reported on October 18, 2023 that: “Governor J.B. Pritzker of Illinois is starting an advocacy group to promote abortion rights around the country seeking to blunt the impact of the Supreme Court’s decision overturning Roe v. Wade. . . Mr. Pritzker, who easily won re-election last year, has not said how much of his own money he will invest in the new organization, but he is worth billions of dollars. The new organization, Think Big America, will fund state ballot measures – typically expensive endeavors – to codify abortion rights in states whose legislatures have enacted or could enact abortion bans. . . One such measure will be on the ballot in Ohio next month.” The website for Think Big America contains a picture of Governor Pritzker with a woman wearing a shirt showing the outline of the State of Illinois and the words “Illinois, where you can get a safe, legal abortion.” See <https://www.thinkbigamerica.com/>
