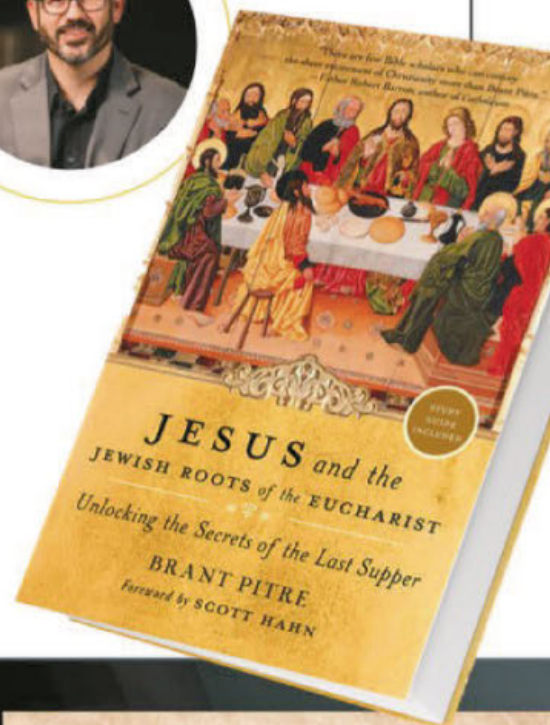

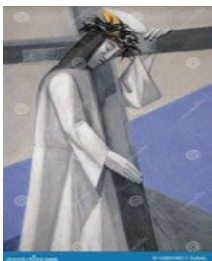

February 25, 2024 - Second Sunday of Lent

As a college student, my prized possession was an after-market car stereo. It was my pride and joy: glorious audio, eye-catching display screen, and multi-disc CD changer. It drained my hard-earned dollars, but it was totally worth it. It drenched me in music everywhere I drove. On Ash Wednesday of my senior year of college, Father Tom, the Jesuit priest at my university said, "Pray for God to tell you what he wants you to sacrifice for Lent." I did. In my heart, the answer came: "Give up listening to your car stereo for forty days." I winced. Not possible, I thought. Can't do it. I made other plans. The next morning, I was stunned to find that my car had been broken into, and my fancy stereo ripped out and stolen.

God's command to sacrifice what we love is no joke. This week in Genesis 22, God says: "Abraham!" "Here I am," he replied. Then God said, "Take your son, your only son, whom you love — Isaac — and go to the region of Moriah. Sacrifice him there as a burnt offering on a mountain I will show you." Believe me, I know. We like to be in control. It chafes us that God sets the terms of what we must sacrifice, and how. But this is no impersonal, tyrannical process. Remember that God uses their names, Abraham and Isaac. God knows each one of us and the precious gifts He commands us to offer. Finally, our sacrifices are for our own good. Do we trust this enough to do what Father Tom asked me to do?

Lenten challenge: This week, I dare you to ask God: "What do you want me to give up?" He may ask for that which you love most. It will be something precious to you: time, money, a relationship, a dream, an opportunity. What matters is we trust Him and act sacrificially in line with His command. Whatever we sacrifice will of course come back to us as surely as the Risen Jesus — but that doesn't make it easy.

Iluminación para la esperanza en nuestra vida debe ser la experiencia de la Transfiguración. Pedro, Santiago y Juan acompañaron a Jesús, subieron a lo alto del monte para ver la manifestación de que Jesús era Dios. Fueron testigos de que junto a Jesús estaban Moisés y Elías, que conversaban con él y que eran los portavoces de la ley y los profetas. Para admiración de ellos, de una nube salió una voz que decía: "Este es mi Hijo, el Amado, escúchenlo" (Marcos 9, 7). Escuchar a Dios en la actualidad es difícil, estamos muy distraídos con tantas cosas. Debemos apagar el celular para darnos cuenta de la magnitud del mensaje de hoy.

Es una gracia, un don, el saber escuchar. Será por eso la insistencia de Dios en este domingo de que escuchemos al Amado. Jesús intentaba ayudar a sus discípulos a entender el mensaje de su Pasión, pero, era difícil para ellos. La Transfiguración indica la esperanza de que después de pasar por el Viernes Santo vendrá la resurrección. Hay que pasar por el sufrimiento para merecer la Gloria prometida. ¿Cómo escucho la palabra de Dios? ¿De qué modo la hago mía y la vivo? El Papa Francisco sobre este Domingo nos dice que "La Fiesta de la Transfiguración del Señor nos recuerda que estamos llamados a vivir el encuentro con Cristo, para que iluminados por su luz, podamos llevarla y hacerla brillar en todas partes, como pequeñas lámparas del Evangelio que llevan un poco de amor y de esperanza" (08-06-2021). ¡Escuchemos la voz de los marginados y hagamos algo por ellos!

PRO-LIFE UPDATE, February 2024

Next month the United States Supreme Court will hear arguments in a case involving the availability of Mifepristone one of the two drugs used in chemical abortions. More than 50% of all abortions in our country are now performed by administration of drugs rather than by surgery. We reported in previous Pro-Life Updates, published in March, April, May, and August 2023, about how Mifepristone is used to cause abortions. A pregnant woman takes a dose of the drug which causes the death of the fetus by starvation. A second drug, Misopristol, is then consumed to cause contractions and expulsion of the dead fetus. See "Everything You Need to Know About THE ABORTION PILL", Population Research Institute, <https://www.pop.org/abortion-pill-fact-sheet/>. Last year a federal appellate court in Texas decided that some aspects of the approval of Mifepristone by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) were improper. Specifically, that court ruled that the FDA should not have allowed the drug: to be administered any time up to 10 weeks of gestation rather than the previously approved 7 weeks; to be prescribed by certain professionals other than medical doctors; or to be delivered to pregnant women by U.S. Mail. The FDA and the manufacturers of Mifepristone appealed to the Supreme Court, which later issued an order placing that ruling on hold. Briefs were submitted and the oral arguments were set for March 26, 2024. Please pray for a decision restricting the use of a drug used to cause the death of many thousands of babies in the womb.

An important lawsuit regarding crisis pregnancy centers (CPCs) is pending in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Illinois, National Institute of Family and Life Advocates (NIFLA) v. Mario Treto, Jr. In that case the constitutionality of an amendment to the Illinois Health Care Right of Conscience Act is at issue. The amended statute requires medical providers who do not perform abortions to refer or transfer patients to abortion providers. CPCs are faith based Christian organizations who provide material assistance to pregnant patients and counsel them to choose life for their unborn children rather than abortion. They do not provide abortions. However, CPCs do provide certain medical procedures such as ultrasounds, pregnancy testing, and testing for sexually transmitted diseases. Therefore, the amended law applies to them. In this lawsuit, the CPCs and NIFLA assert that the law violates their First Amendment rights to freedom of speech and free exercise of religion by forcing them to refer pregnant women to abortion providers. The defendants are represented by the Illinois Attorney General who claims that the statute is constitutional, and that CPCs should be required to make abortion referrals to patients as set forth in the amendment. The Court heard 20 hours of evidence over a three-day period in September 2023 and the parties have submitted briefs in support of their positions. The judge will now consider the facts developed by the evidence and the applicable law. A decision is expected some time in the next few months. An adverse ruling would certainly destroy or, at the very least, severely handicap CPCs' ability to persuade their pregnant patients to choose life over abortion. Our parish is currently collecting money for a CPC, The Women's Center of Greater Chicagoland, through the Baby Bottle Project. In the spirit of Lenten almsgiving please be as generous as your circumstances allow. Also please pray for a court decision in favor of the CPCs and join us for a Pro-life Mass followed by the Rosary for Pro-Life intentions at 8:00 AM on Saturday, March 2, 2024.

Lent 2024

We know that Ash Wednesday ushers in the Lenten season which lasts for 40 days. Lenten practices have changed through the centuries, however, the focus remains the same: to repent of sin, to renew our faith, and to prepare to celebrate joyfully the mysteries of our salvation. Let's focus on the practice "to renew our faith." The prophet Isaiah says: "Remember not the events of the past, the things of long ago consider not; see, I am doing something new! Now it springs forth, do you not perceive it?" (Isaiah 43: 18-19). Could this be a message for our parish for this Lenten Season of 2023? Perhaps the Lord wants to do something new with us! Perhaps he wants us to grow stronger, closer, and more active as a community! These are some of the ways your talents would be a blessing to Blessed Sacrament Parish: *Become a Lector, *Become a Eucharistic Minister, *Become an Usher, *Join the Knights of Columbus, *Pray the First Saturday of the month Pro-Life Rosary, *Become a Catechetical Teacher, *Join the Legion of Mary, *Volunteer at the Food Pantry on the 1st and 3rd Mondays of the month, *Join the Liturgy Committee, *Join the Choir, *Sign up for an hour of prayer at the Eucharistic Adoration Chapel *Attend weekday morning Mass often, *Attend the First Friday Evening Mass in honor of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, *Join the Book Club, or * Pray the Stations of the Cross during Lent. Let us pray during this Lenten Season for the grace to join or participate in at least one of the above ministries, devotions, or clubs.

Estas son algunas de las formas en que sus talentos serían una bendición para la Parroquia del Santísimo Sacramento: *Conviértete en Lector, *Conviértete en Ministro Eucarístico, *Conviértete en Ujier, *Únete a los Caballeros de Colón, *Reza el Rosario Pro-Vida, *Conviértete en catequista, *Únete a la Legión de María, *Trabaja como voluntario en la despensa de alimentos, *Únete al comité de liturgia, *Únete al coro, *Regístrate para una hora de oración en la Capilla de Adoración Eucarística *Asiste a misa entre semana con frecuencia, *Asiste a la misa vespertina del primer viernes en honor al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús, *Únete a Lectio Devina, o * Reza las Estaciones de la Cruz durante la Cuaresma. Oremos durante esta temporada de Cuaresma por la gracia de unirnos o participar en al menos uno de los ministerios, devociones o grupos mencionados.

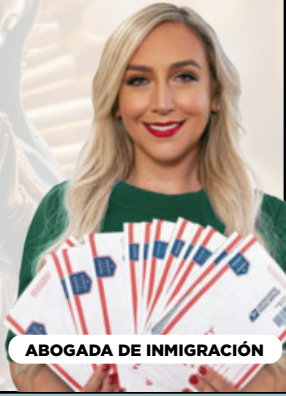
