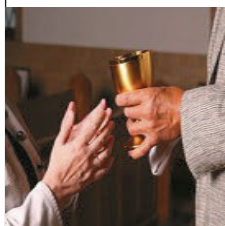
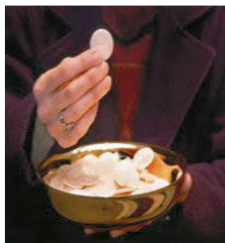
Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Word of God Speaks to Us: Love in Action

Since last Sunday, we continue to reflect upon the theme of discipleship. To follow Jesus requires us to abandon everything and follow our Lord's footsteps by embodying his message and modeling our lifestyle to His. Today's readings challenge us to make the right choices in life and opt for God's will. The first reading (1Sm 26:2,7-9,12-13,23-23) shows us how David made the right choice, respecting God's anointed king by forgiving his offenses, while Saul continued to make the wrong choices, perpetuating his own misery in seeking his revenge. In the second reading (1 Cor15:45-49), St. Paul tells us how the "First Adam" made a wrong choice of disobedience, bringing death into the world, whereas Jesus, the "Second Adam," made the right choice of fulfilling his Father's saving plan for mankind by accepting acute suffering and a heinous death. In the Gospel (Lk 6:27-38), Jesus advises us to choose the "golden rule" including loving our enemies and showing sensitivity to the feelings and needs of others. We need to choose unconditional, agape love instead of envy, jealousy and hatred in our relationships with others. This love also requires us to extend a helping hand to those in need. As the theme of this year's Annual Catholic Appeal says: "together we bring hope," we show love in action and bring hope to others by supporting the parishes, schools, ministries, programs and agencies that serve the many needs of the people of the archdiocese. I urge you to pray and donate your gift for the cause of the appeal.

I also remind you about our commitment to building a vibrant community of missionary disciples. Christian discipleship is rooted in our relationship with the Eucharistic Lord who is our Hope. I invite you to take some time to visit the Blessed Sacrament and spend some time with the Lord. I exhort parents with their children to be pilgrims of hope by visiting our Perpetual Adoration Chapel. We have the responsibility to bring our children to Jesus; it's a learning and life fulfilling experience that transforms our lives. Finally, Lent is around the corner. You should plan how you want to live out the spirit of lent, individually and collectively. The parish will provide some spiritual resources such as retreats, the Stations of the Cross, the recitation of the rosary, confessions, and other ways to do the works of mercy. I urge you to take advantage of those resources designed to increase individual and parish spiritual renewal. The theme of Lent is Hope and Eucharist. We want to follow and deepen our relationship with our Lord Jesus who is the source of hope. The Sacrifice of the Cross is the revelation and symbol of Christian hope. Please, find the Lenten resources and information in our bulletin and on the parish website.

As always, remember our discipleship challenge to bring or invite one friend or family member to Church. Together we can bring hope!

La Palabra de Dios nos habla: El amor en acción

Desde el domingo pasado, continuamos reflexionando sobre el tema del discipulado. Seguir a Jesús requiere que abandonemos todo y sigamos los pasos de nuestro Señor encarnando su mensaje y modelando nuestro estilo de vida según el suyo. Las lecturas de hoy nos desafían a tomar las decisiones correctas en la vida y optar por la voluntad de Dios. La primera lectura (1 Sam 26:2,7-9,12-13,23-23) nos muestra cómo David tomó la decisión correcta, respetando al rey ungido de Dios al perdonar sus ofensas, mientras que Saúl continuó tomando decisiones equivocadas, perpetuando su propia miseria en busca de venganza. En la segunda lectura (1 Cor 15:45-49), San Pablo nos cuenta cómo el "primer Adán" tomó una decisión equivocada de desobediencia, trayendo la muerte al mundo, mientras que Jesús, el "segundo Adán", tomó la decisión correcta de cumplir el plan salvador de su Padre para la humanidad al aceptar un sufrimiento agudo y una muerte atroz. En el Evangelio (Lc 6,27-38), Jesús nos aconseja que elijamos la "regla de oro", que incluye amar a nuestros enemigos y mostrar sensibilidad hacia los sentimientos y necesidades de los demás. Debemos elegir el amor incondicional, el amor ágape, en lugar de la envidia, los celos y el odio en nuestras relaciones con los demás. Este amor también requiere que extendamos una mano amiga a los necesitados. Como dice el tema de la Campaña Católica Anual de este año: "juntos llevamos esperanza", mostramos amor en acción y llevamos esperanza a los demás apoyando a las parroquias, escuelas, ministerios, programas y agencias que atienden las muchas necesidades de la gente de la archidiócesis. Los insto a que oren y donen su donativo para la causa de la campaña.

También les recuerdo nuestro compromiso de construir una comunidad vibrante de discípulos misioneros. El discipulado cristiano tiene sus raíces en nuestra relación con el Señor Eucarístico, que es nuestra Esperanza. Los invito a tomarse un tiempo para visitar el Santísimo Sacramento y pasar un tiempo con el Señor. Exhorto a los padres con sus hijos a ser peregrinos de esperanza visitando nuestra Capilla de Adoración Perpetua. Tenemos la responsabilidad de llevar a nuestros hijos a Jesús; es una experiencia de aprendizaje y plenitud que transforma nuestras vidas. Finalmente, la Cuaresma está a la vuelta de la esquina. Deben planificar cómo quieren vivir el espíritu de la Cuaresma, individual y colectivamente. La parroquia proporcionará algunos recursos espirituales como retiros, el Vía Crucis, el rezo del rosario, confesiones y otras formas de hacer las obras de misericordia. Los insto a aprovechar esos recursos diseñados para aumentar la renovación espiritual individual y parroquial. El tema de la Cuaresma es la Esperanza y la Eucaristía. Queremos seguir y profundizar nuestra relación con nuestro Señor Jesús, que es la fuente de esperanza. El Sacrificio de la Cruz es la revelación y el símbolo de la esperanza cristiana. Por favor, encuentre los recursos e información de Cuaresma en nuestro boletín y en el sitio web de la parroquia.

Como siempre, recuerden nuestro desafío de discipulado de traer o invitar a un amigo o familiar a la Iglesia. ¡Juntos podemos traer esperanza!

Jubilee 2025



This Jubilee Year of 2025 calls Christians to action. Pope Francis called for “signs of hope” in the Jubilee Year, including the desire for peace in the world, openness to life and responsible parenthood, and closeness to prisoners, the poor, the sick, the young, the elderly, migrants and people “in difficult situations.” Pope Francis has called on affluent countries to forgive the debts of countries that would never be able to repay them, and address “ecological debt,” which he described as “connected to commercial imbalances with effects on the environment and the disproportionate use of natural resources by certain countries over long periods of time.”

El Papa Francisco ha pedido a los países ricos que perdonen las deudas de los países que nunca podrían pagarlas y que aborden la “deuda ecológica”, que describió como “vinculada a desequilibrios comerciales con efectos sobre el medio ambiente y al uso desproporcionado de los recursos naturales por parte de ciertos países durante largos períodos de tiempo”.

Pro-Life Update March 2025

Most abortions in our country currently are performed by administration of drugs. According to the Guttmacher Institute, a research and policy organization committed to advancing “sexual and reproductive health rights”, medication abortions in the US increased from 53% of all abortions in 2020 to 63% in 2023. Last year the United States Supreme Court heard argument in a lawsuit from Texas which sought to ban one of the two drugs used in medication abortions. See our August 2024 and April 2023 ProLife Updates for a description of that suit. The Court dismissed it because it found that the plaintiff’s did not have legal standing to file the complaint. However, pro-life activists and organizations will continue to look for a lawful basis to restrict the use of the drugs—mifepristone and misoprostol. It is also possible that the Trump Administration, which now controls the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) could attempt other measures. Robert F. Kennedy, Jr. was recently confirmed as the Secretary of Health and Human Services (HHS). The FDA is an agency of the federal government within HHS. Mr. Kennedy, who in the past has expressed “pro-choice” sentiments, seems to be changing his opinions on life issues. During his Senate confirmation hearing he stated “[we cannot be a moral nation if we have 1.2 million abortions a year” and that he and President Trump had not yet made any decisions about regulation of mifepristone. Another legal issue has recently arisen regarding abortion pills. On December 12, 2024 the Texas Attorney General filed a petition in Texas court against a New York physician, Dr. Margaret Daley Carpenter, alleging that the doctor violated Texas law by: practicing medicine in Texas without a Texas license; providing abortion inducing drugs via telemedicine to a pregnant Texas woman causing abortion complications and a medical abortion; seeing Texas patients via telehealth and prescribing abortion-inducing medications to Texas patients. The Texas Court issued an order on February 13, 2025 against the New York doctor requiring her to pay \$100,000 plus \$12,400 attorney fees and enjoined the doctor from prescribing abortion-inducing drugs to Texas residents. The order also permanently enjoined Dr. Daley Carpenter from any further violation of Texas laws including those prohibiting provision of abortion drugs by courier, delivery, or mail service, or to women more than 49 days pregnant. It is likely there will be appeals in this case and similar suits involving sending abortion pills from states with laws favorable to abortion, like New York, into other states, like Texas, with restrictive abortion laws. *Our next monthly Pro-Life Mass and Rosary will be at 8:00 AM on Saturday March 1, 2025, please join us.*

Several weeks ago, we asked if anyone would like to share a personal faith story of their Eucharistic experience. The following article was submitted by a newcomer to Blessed Sacrament Parish.

My name is Angelena Centille, and I am a newcomer to Blessed Sacrament Parish. I started coming to Blessed Sacrament in mid-December 2024, and I immediately felt accepted and welcome. This has given me so much joy and hope. I am very happy with my choice to attend Blessed Sacrament. I have joined the book club and look forward to more parish related events and activities. My faith has wavered over the years. I grew up going to Catholic school and loved being deeply committed to my faith even as a small child. I was an active altar server and looked forward to that every week. Upon entering middle school, I had to attend public school for a year and a half, then deep anxiety and depression took over my life and have been a constant ever since. I went back to a Catholic middle and high school in Northwest Indiana and had a very difficult experience with teachers and administration criticizing my faith and telling me very negative and judgmental things, which negatively affected my faith.

Now as a 33-year-old woman, after much thought and contemplation, I am comfortable expressing my faith and going back to Mass. It was difficult at first, with quite a bit of crying, but I believe it was all positive. What I think was my major turning point was when my husband and I found out our dog was terminally ill in early November. That evening, we had to take her to an Emergency vet, and I prayed the rosary for the first time in over 20 years in hopes of getting some type of answer regarding her suffering, which we did. I took that as a sign and that began my thinking of returning to the Catholic Church. My connection to God is deepened by my receiving the Eucharist each Sunday. By accepting this ultimate gift, I am blessed physically and spiritually and able to shed my fears and face the week with more strength and direction. Upon leaving Sunday mass I feel the sun shines brighter and the birds are singing in celebration of the Eucharist. I hope that all who receive it also feel this joy. My goal is to strengthen my relationship with the Eucharistic Lord by visiting frequently the Adoration Chapel.
