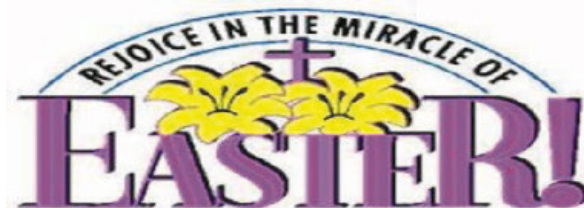

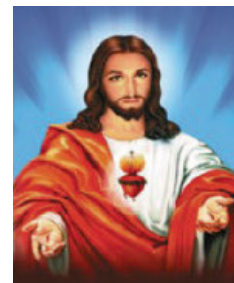

PRO-LIFE UPDATE, March 2024

On February 16, 2024, the Supreme Court of Alabama decided the case of *LePage v. Center for Reproductive Medicine* which held that human embryos are considered “minor children” under the law of that state. The case involved unborn babies which were created by means of in vitro fertilization but had not yet been implanted into a woman’s uterus. The embryos were frozen and held in a “cryogenic nursery” operated by a “fertility clinic” in the same building as a hospital. A hospital patient entered the clinic through an unsecured doorway and removed several embryos from the container in which they were kept. “The subzero temperatures at which the embryos had been stored freeze-burned the patient’s hand, causing the patient to drop the embryos on the floor, killing them.” An Alabama statute -- the “Wrongful Death of a Minor Act” -- provides that parents can bring a lawsuit to obtain a judgment for punitive damages from persons or companies who cause the death of their minor children. The court found that the statute clearly applied “on its face to all unborn children without limitation.” The court’s opinion went on to explain the process of in vitro fertilization (IVF) as follows. Doctors assist prospective parents to conceive children “by joining the mother’s eggs with the father’s sperm ‘in vitro’ – that is, outside the mother’s body.” Then the resulting embryos are “artificially gestated” to “a few days of age.” They are then frozen in the “cryogenic nursery” until they are implanted into the mother’s uterus at some later time.

Interestingly, the Alabama noted that all of the parties to the case and all of the justices on the court agreed “that an unborn child is a genetically unique human being whose life begins at fertilization and ends at death” and that “an unborn child usually qualifies as a ‘human life,’ ‘human being’ or ‘person,’ as those words are used in ordinary conversation.” The Alabama decision was immediately criticized severely by politicians and others in favor of legalized abortion. Apparently, they were quite upset that a court had found that embryos could be considered living human beings which would logically lead to the conclusion that aborting an unborn child is the taking of a human life. Five days after the Alabama court announced its ruling, the CEO of Planned Parenthood publicly stated that the decision holding “stored embryos may be considered ‘unborn children’ is the devastating consequence of fetal personhood statutes and demonstrates the risk of these laws for all reproductive care.” On February 22, 2024 President Biden called the ruling “outrageous and unacceptable” and said “make no mistake: this is a direct result of the overturning of *Roe v. Wade*.” He further promised to keep fighting for women’s reproductive rights “until we restore the protections of *Roe v. Wade* in federal law for all women in every state.” On March 14, 2024, Vice President Harris visited an abortion clinic in Saint, Paul Minnesota, the first U.S. Vice President to do so. On that occasion she criticized the U.S. Supreme Court decision which reversed *Roe v. Wade* and promised that Congress would pass a bill codifying “abortion rights” if her party won back the House of Representatives.

The Catholic Church has long recognized that from the time of conception an embryo must be treated as a “person” and “defended in its integrity, cared for and healed, as far as possible, like any other human being.” See *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, Paragraphs 2274 and 2275. The Church also has declared in vitro fertilization to be immoral. See **Instruction on Respect for Human Life In Its Origin**, February 22, 1987, **Joseph Cardinal Ratzinger**, Prefect of Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith, which states that: “Human embryos obtained in vitro are human beings and subjects with rights; their dignity and right to life must be respected from the first moment of their existence. It is immoral to produce human embryos destined to be exploited as disposable, ‘biological material’ In the usual practice of in vitro fertilization, not all of the embryos are transferred to the woman’s body; some are destroyed.” We should pray unceasingly that unborn children are protected from destruction and protected by our laws and public policies as are all other human beings. Please join us for our Pro-life Mass followed by the Rosary for Pro-Life intentions at 8:00 AM on Saturday, April 6, 2024.

March 31, 2024 - Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord

Outside Chicago, there is a small cemetery in the woods behind Mundelein Seminary, where I was a student. One night I was exploring it. I looked up and was shocked to see an imposing seventeen-foot angel towering over me and preparing to blow a trumpet. Adrenaline rushed through me. I gasped and uttered, "Oh my God!" Quickly I realized it was in fact a massive bronze statue. I tried to calm myself down. But it still freaked me out.

As we begin to celebrate Easter today, this image might seem a bit unnerving. But please recall that for the first disciples on the morning of the resurrection, it was precisely that. It wasn't joyful at first, it was terrifying. It wasn't peaceful, it was unsettling. In that Jerusalem cemetery, something otherworldly had happened. Angels announced that he was no longer dead, but alive. They had blown their trumpets, so to speak, and Jesus had risen. Soon the disciples' shock in that dark cemetery would turn into joy.

We all have our own places of the dead, too, don't we? Deceased loved ones. Our tired patterns of blame. Relationships stuck in resentment. Indifference to the poor. Lost dreams. Despair about our future. Fear of sickness and death. These are our "cemeteries" where we don't expect much to happen. Today we enter — if we dare — those places with the disciples. See the mighty angel standing there, trumpet ready to blare! — *Father John Muir* ©LPi

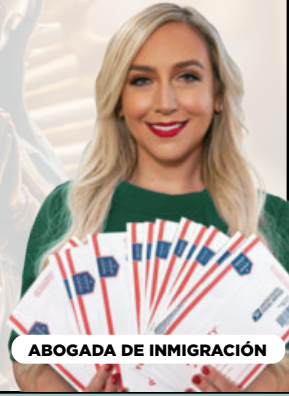
