FR. ISMAEL'S THOUGHTS

When I was just ordained a priest, I had a very naive idea of the priestly identity. I wanted everyone I met to see Christ in me; that they always could have a meaningful and fruitful encounter. In other words, that everyone would be content and happy after meeting with me, that everyone may be pleased by me. I really tried for a couple of months, but after a while, I realized that it was an impossible task: as hard as I tried to please everyone, not everyone was pleased with me. If Jesus was not able to do that (he was put to death because some people were upset with him), how could I think I was going to be successful. Then, I decided the only person that I needed to please would be God.

Today's gospel narrates the parable of the two sons who were told by their father to go and work in his vineyard. And the one who did the father's will was the first, who did go to the vineyard. All of us are called to do our Father's will, but we have so many people in our lives that have expectations from us: parents, children, siblings, friends, coworkers, neighbors, etc. And because we hear their comments and opinions, we have the temptation to do what they want. But as hard as we can try, we will never please everybody.

So, we must keep in our minds that the only one for us to please is God, nobody else. But to do that, we need to have a connection with Him, we need to have an open communication with the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. As the first child in today's parable, may we all be eager to do the Father's will.

BOILER ISSUES

As you may remember, 3 years ago we replaced the church boiler, but we found out that there are some issues that need to be addressed. When it was installed, the manufacturer recommended to install a pump to keep moving certain chemicals that were needed to properly operate the boiler. Somehow, the contractor did not install the pump and now, there is some deterioration that is causing some leaking. The boiler installed is discontinued and replacement parts are not available. The contractor was bought by a bigger company, and we do not know if they would be responsible for the problem (the archdiocese is helping us to find out about it). But we need to install another boiler before winter. It is very upsetting, but this is something we need to do in the next few weeks.

Also, we need to replace the boiler at the Pastoral Center (former Convent) but it seems that it will last for another winter. So, that one will be replaced next year. I will keep you informed of how things are going.

PENSAMIENTOS DEL P. ISMAEL

Cuando fui ordenado sacerdote, tenía una idea muy ingenua de la identidad sacerdotal. Quería que cualquier persona con quien me encontrara, pudiera ver en mí a Cristo mismo; que siempre tuvieran un encuentro significativo, que todos puedan estar complacidos. Realmente lo intento durante un par de meses, pero después de un tiempo, me doy cuenta de que era una tarea imposible: por mucho que traté de complacer a todos, no todos estaban contentos conmigo. Si Jesús no fue capaz de hacer eso (fue condenado a muerte porque algunas personas estaban molestas con él), ¿cómo podría pensar que iba a tener éxito? Entonces decidí que la única persona a la que necesitaba complacer sería Dios.

En el evangelio de hoy escuchamos acerca de la parábola de los dos hijos a quienes su padre les dijo que fueran a trabajar en su viña. Y el que hizo la voluntad del padre fue el segundo, que fue a la viña. Todos estamos llamados a hacer la voluntad de nuestro Padre, pero tenemos tantas personas en nuestras vidas que tienen expectativas de nosotros: padres, hijos, hermanos, amigos, compañeros de trabajo, vecinos, etc. Y porque escuchamos sus comentarios y opiniones, tenemos la tentación de hacer lo que quieren. Pero por mucho que podamos intentarlo, nunca complacernos a todos.

Por lo tanto, debemos tener en mente que al único que debemos de agradar es Dios y a nadie más. Pero para hacer eso, necesitamos tener conexión con Él, necesitamos tener una comunicación abierta con el Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo. Como el segundo hijo en la parábola de hoy, que todos estemos ansiosos por hacer la voluntad del Padre.

PROBLEMAS DEL BOILER

Como recordarán, hace 3 años reemplazamos el boiler del templo, pero ahora tenemos algunos problemas que deben solucionarse. Cuando se instaló, el fabricante recomendó instalar una bomba para seguir moviendo ciertos químicos que eran necesarios para el funcionamiento correcto. De alguna manera, el contratista no la instaló y ahora hay un deterioro que produce algunas fugas. El boiler instalado ya está discontinuado y no hay partes de repuesto. El contratista que lo instaló fue comprado por una empresa más grande, y no sabemos si se harán responsables del problema (la arquidiócesis nos está ayudando a averiguarlo). Pero necesitamos instalar otro boiler antes del invierno. Es muy molesto, pero eso es algo que tenemos que hacer en las próximas semanas.

Además, necesitamos reemplazar el boiler en el Centro Pastoral (antiguo Convento), pero parece que durará funcionando otro invierno. Entonces, ese lo reemplazaremos hasta el próximo año. Les mantendré informados sobre estos asuntos.

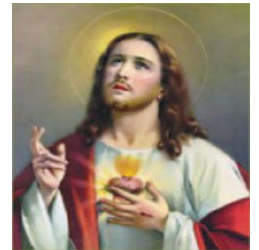

PRO-LIFE UPDATE, SEPTEMBER 2023

Once again there was good news and bad news on the pro-life front this past month – bad news from Wisconsin and good news from South Carolina and West Virginia. Also there is news in Illinois – but we do not yet know if it will be good or bad.

After a one-year hiatus Planned Parenthood has resumed scheduling abortions in Wisconsin. Abortions were halted in that state after the Dobbs decision overruling Roe v. Wade. That halt was based on an 1849 state law which prohibited the “intentional destruction of an unborn child which had been unenforceable during the 50 years that Roe was in force. Recently a Dane County, Wisconsin judge held that the 1849 statute was intended to prohibit only “feticide”—the killing of an unborn by a criminal attack on the pregnant woman -- but not an “abortion” performed with the woman’s consent. So far there is no indication whether this decision be appealed. Over the last 15 months many pregnant Wisconsin women went to other states, including Illinois, to abort their unborn babies. For example, the Women’s Medical Fund of Wisconsin reported that it gave financial assistance to 477 such women in the first six months of 2023.

The South Carolina 2023 Fetal Heartbeat and Protection from Abortion Act was declared constitutional by that state’s Supreme Court on August 23, 2023. The law generally prohibits abortion after detection of a fetal heartbeat with limited exceptions allowing abortion in the event of risk to the health of the mother, fatal fetal anomalies, rape or incest. This law has an interesting legislative history. Earlier this year that Court had found a previous anti-abortion statute passed in 2021 to be unconstitutional. Thereafter, the state legislature made some revisions to the law which caused one justice to change vote differently when the revised law was evaluated.

The West Virginia Unborn Child Protection Act (UCPA) enacted in September, 2022 declared it illegal to perform, induce, or attempt to perform or induce an abortion subject to certain very limited exceptions. W. Va. Code § 16-2R-3. The UCPA expressly includes abortions performed by use of a “medicine” or “drug.” Genbiopro, Inc., a company which manufactures generic mifepristone, which is used in medication abortions, filed a lawsuit seeking a declaration that the West Virginia abortion ban was “invalid and unenforceable” because by making abortions illegal West Virginia had prevented the company from marketing and distributing a drug approved for use by the Federal Drug Administration (FDA). On August 24, 2023, the U.S District Court for the Southern District of West Virginia dismissed most of Genbiopro’s suit holding that FDA approval of the drug did not preempt the State’s ability to outlaw abortion even though that would result in reduced sales of mifepristone.

Additionally, an important trial recently concluded in the U.S District Court for the Northern District of Illinois. At issue was the constitutionality of a 2016 amendment to the Illinois Health Care Right of Conscience Act. The amendment required physicians, health care providers, and any other persons who provide counseling or advice regarding abortion, contraception, or other health care, including those conscientiously opposed to abortion, to inform patients of all “legal treatment options” and the “risks and benefits” of such options, which of course includes abortion, and to refer the patients to physicians or facilities who will provide abortions. Suit was brought by a pro-life physician and a crisis pregnancy organization seeking a court order preventing the State of Illinois from forcing them to provide such referrals and advice in violation of their sincerely held moral and religious beliefs. The Plaintiffs claimed that this violated their First Amendment rights by compelling them to tell others that abortion has “benefits” which, of course, they do not believe. In 2017 the court granted a preliminary injunction barring the State from enforcing the amendment pending completion of the litigation. This past month the Court heard evidence for three days ending on September 23, 2023 and is expected to render a decision in about one month. Pray for a pro-life result in this case.

Please join us for the next pro-life Mass and Rosary on Saturday, October 2, 2023, at 8:00 AM. 

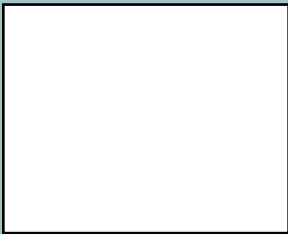
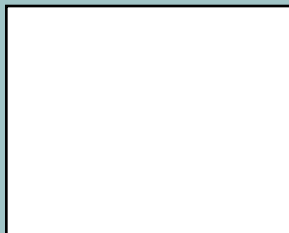
